

Monthly Activities of Sialkot Chamber

AWARENESS SEMINAR ON "CYBER SECURITY" BY CATALYIC CONSULTING (PVT) LTD.



Seminar was held on July 02, 2019 at SCCI. Mr. Omer Khalid, Chairman Departmental Committee on Media/ Cybercrime welcomed the team from Catalyic Consulting Pvt. Ltd., Lahore and mentioned that the hackers were targeting the businessmen's email/ domains repeatedly in recent years. He informed that the most commonly used hacking methodology was "Man in the middle attack" prevailing in the Industry of Sialkot. He further added that businessmen were not much aware about cyber-security; they might be functioning on a very small scale with limited resources and were unable to equip themselves with the necessary protection in the said regard. He shared that Sialkot Industry needed a solution that was not much expensive, was easy to be learned and was able to concentrate on the emerging Cyber issues being faced.

Mr. Farhan Mirza, CEO of Catalyic Consulting Pvt Ltd briefed about the company and its notable projects. Mr. Bilal Islam, Marketing Manager shared that annually US\$ 400 Billion were lost in the Cyber Crime activities; the cracked software and patches used by the businesses were a big gap in the security of their operations. He shared that Catalyic Consulting Pvt Ltd was determined to provide the free of cost penetration testing. He said that a thorough study of the challenges being faced by the industry would help the firm to make estimation about the reduced cost and better security services provided. He mentioned that major security threats were hacking, viruses, malware, ransomware, password hijacking. Moreover, he said that Cyber Crimes included illegal access and interception, system interference, misuse of devices and frauds. Furthermore, the benefit of using cyber security was to eliminate the risk and safeguard the information, it also helped in understanding the vulnerabilities.

DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON FAIR & EXHIBITION/ DELEGATIONS



Meeting of Departmental Committee on Fairs & Exhibition/Delegation was held on July 10, 2019 at Sialkot Chamber under the leadership of Mr. Muhammad Sarfraz Butt Chairman Committee. He welcomed & congratulated the delegates of Surgical Specific Trade Delegation to China. He gave the detail working of the committee regarding the collaboration with Embassy and he had persuaded the Embassy of Pakistan in China, through meeting with the Ambassador and requested him to facilitate Sialkot Chamber. Sialkot Chamber would also help them to arranging the meetings of the delegates with clients of their choice. He also told that Commercial Counsellor had further referred them to Pakistan-China Joint Chamber of Commerce and Industry, who would help in arranging Business to Business meetings of the delegates since his health could not allow him to work, and he was on leave. Mr. Umer Khalid, Mr. Khaliq Mehmood Mughal and other members appreciated the Chairman, discussed the concerns and shared their suggestions regarding the China Delegation; After detailed discussion and due deliberation, the Committee had decided the matters e.g. Visa Application, meetings with Commercial Section & Consulates of Pakistan etc.

DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON ENGINEERING

Meeting of Departmental Committee on Engineering was held on July 12, 2109. Mr. Zahid Hussain Mughal, Chairman chaired the meeting. He welcomed all the members and shared these immature measures of the

Government would create un-employment and uncertainty in the society. Mr. Ikram ul Haq, Chairman Departmental Committee on Surgical/ Dental/ Veterinary/ Personal Care thanked and discussed the tax related policies of current Government; he further said that new Tax regime was very complex due which the industry would face double taxation. Sialkot Industry exported 60 percent of the world's demand of Surgical and Dental instruments. He further said that new policies of the Government would create uncertainty and would severely affect the Cottage Industry.

The house unanimously rejected the new tax regime imposed on the Sialkot Industry and condemned the implications faced by Forging, Auto part and Machine Manufacturing sector of Daska Industry by Taxes and Harassment being faced by the Industrial due to Tax Raid of FBR.

VISIT OF H.E. MR. IWAN SUYUDHIE AMRI, AMBASSADOR OF REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA



His Excellency Mr. Iwan Suyudhie Amri, Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to Pakistan and honorable Officials of the Embassy had visited the Sialkot Chamber on July 12, 2109. Mr. Wagas Akram Awan, Senior Vice President SCCI welcomed the distinguished guests and members of this Chamber. Indonesia, the largest populated country in the Islamic world, was a true friend of Pakistan; both Islamic countries were striving for worldwide peace, promoting tolerance, fighting to get rid of terrorism, extremism and endeavoring to settle problems and differences by peaceful means and dialogues. Pakistan and Indonesia were committed and making joint efforts towards promotion of bilateral relations especially the trade. Therefore, in order to overcome the problems for progressive development in every sector, it was important to collaborate and develop a coordinated approach and strategy for the betterment of the people of the two brotherly countries. As per the Ministry of Commerce, Pakistan, total trade volume between the two countries in FY 2017-18 was USD 2.8 (B) with balance of trade strongly in favor of Indonesia. However, there was a lot of potential to increase this volume of trade. He also suggested a few measures for the expansion of trade between the two countries. He shared that Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry was the representative body of the Private Sector of Sialkot and was greatly contributing in the economic development of the country.



H.E. Mr. Iwan Suyudhie Amri, Ambassador thanked and shared the history of Indonesia and told about the Government to Government and cultural relations of both brotherly countries; he mentioned the "Army to Army" and "Navy to Navy" interactions & bilateral relations of Indonesia & Pakistan. He told about his meeting with the Pakistan's Chief of Army Staff and their discussion about the value of Pakistan's strategic location in this cooperation. He also assured to start liaising of both the countries' Air force. He told that Indonesia had already signed many MOUs with different Pakistani Universities in Karachi and Islamabad etc. He also told about the total numbers of Indonesian students were studying in Pakistan. Thousands of students were also studying in Madrisa (Raiwind, Lahore); he also shared progressing trade & economic relations of Indonesia and Pakistan. He also shared the facts -- trade of both the countries USD 2.2 (B) in 2016 and USD 3.1 in 2018. He told about an exhibition would planned to conduct in Jakarta, Indonesia on 16-19 Oct, 2019; he welcomed the business community of Sialkot for the said exhibition. He assured that he would work to explore the opportunities for Joint Ventures between both the countries.

PANEL DISCUSSION OF YOUTH ON "PROMOTION OF YOUNG TALENT"

Sheikh Zahid Hameed, Chairman Departmental Committee Garrison HQ / Cantonment Board Affairs

chaired a Panel Discussion of Youth on "Promotion of Young-Talent" on July 13, 2019. He welcomed the Mr. Basim Naser (Law Minister, Youth Parliament, Islamabad), President SCCI and Committee members in the said session and thanked them for contributing with their valuable remarks. All the Committee Members congratulated Mr. Basim Naser on electing as Law Minister, for Youth Parliamentary Affairs and made discussion on the promotion of young talent of the country; especially involvement of youth in youth parliamentary affairs and to utilize the youth in the creative & development work.

Khawaja Masud Akhtar, President Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry thanked for inviting him in the programme and appreciated the involvement of youth in Parliamentary Affairs. While discussion he appreciated the youngsters who participated in that discussion and he also shared some business techniques as well. He also briefed them about the lean manufacturing and six sigma system in detail to make profitable business which was adopted in all over the world especially Japan and China. In the end Sheikh Zahid Hameed thanked all the participants of programme for attending the programme.

DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION (UNIVERSITIES)

Meeting of Departmental Committee on Education (Universities) was held on July 13, 2019. Dr. Khurram Anwar Khawaja, Chairman Committee welcomed all the members and after reviewing the progress/results of the scholarship candidates, the 16 students were found eligible for renewal of scholarship for the next 6 months, i.e. August 2019 to January 2020. The Committee received some new applications for scholarships and found eligible for awarding scholarships for the next 6 months. Furthermore, he shared a report on "Sialkot Chamber Education Program (SCEP)" a joint project of SCCI, Al-Khidmat Foundation and GC Women University Sialkot.

Chairman Committee also shared the concept of a project initiated under the Committee; The Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Al-Khidmat Foundation conceived a project with the collaboration of ORIC of GCWUS to provide free educational coaching to the underprivileged students of Government Schools. Therefore, it was mutually decided to start a project for the students of 9th and 10th classes to improve their

education. Education department was one of the main stakeholders of this program and graciously CO Education and DO Education welcomed & appreciated this idea with surety for complete cooperation as well. Physical education/activities was also taken in to the consideration and it was also decided that with the help of Chamber, students would also be provided the sports goods to involve and encouraged them in extra cocurricular activities. He believed that a healthy body could flourish a healthy mind. It was also decided that stationary shall also be provided to the students for effective learning. He also shared the working and facts & figures regarding the project; whereas, committee had taken important decisions regarding the project e.g. coordinator's remuneration, salary, ceremony, proposed timings etc.

MEETING WITH MR. SAQIB MANAN, COMMISSIONER-PUNJAB EMPLOYEES SOCIAL SECURITY INSTITUTION



Mr. Ammar Faisal Al-Assad welcomed Mr. Sagib Manan, Commissioner, Punjab Employees Social Security Institution, Mr. Khawaja Ahmar Naik, Secretary, Workers Welfare Board, Punjab, and Mr. Abdul Waheed Dar, Director, Social Security Sialkot, and members of Sialkot Chamber on July 16, 2019. After brief introduction of the participants, Mr. Ammar Faisal Al-Assad thanked EC member and began his presentation by giving an overview of existing healthcare facilities under Social Security institution and further amendments. He also highlighted the geographical distances between Sialkot, Pasrur, Narowal and Shakargarh and said that administratively it was not convenient to cater all the four cities less than one Social Security Directorate situated at Sialkot. While referring to the budget allocated for medicine during 2018-19, he informed that only Rs.22 million were allocated for the purpose during the year which resulted in allocation of Rs.433 per year per worker or Rs.77.47 per family member per year, which was quite low. Detail discussion and presentation was held in the meeting on the said agenda point.

Mr. Saqib Manan, Commissioner Punjab Employees Social Security Institution thanked the Chairman and members; while referring to the queries raised during the meeting and he responded with the solid points regarding the discussed matters. Mr. Khawaja Ahmar Naik, Secretary, Workers Welfare Board, Punjab, stated that Workers Welfare Fund was collected by the Federal Government along with Federal Taxes and then allocated to Workers Welfare Board for disbursement to Provincial Workers Welfare Boards. He also gave the detail briefings on new labour colonies, funds, pendency, budget and disbursement of claims etc. After due deliberation, it was decided that; A delegation of Sialkot Chamber would meet The Commissioner, PESSI, at his office in Lahore to deliberate on and finalize proposals discussed during the meeting and The matter of donation to the Workers' Welfare Schools would be considered in the light of recommendations of the relevant departmental committee.

CONSULTANT SESSION OF XAVOR CORPORATION



Khawaja Masud Akhtar (SI) President SCCI chaired the session and welcomed the team of Xavor Corporation at SCCI on July 15, 2019. He said that despite Sialkot Industry was facing immense issues related to turbulent economy, non-business friendly policies and recent Federal Budget 2019-20 had added levy of taxes on the industry. He further added in recent years China had spread around the world because of their pro-business policies and a clear vision, even though competitiveness of the Chinese model had been suffered due to increase in operating cost, still they had managed to keep their growth up. He said that being a consultative company

Xavor corporation could help Sialkot Chamber in establishing factors that would make Sialkot Industry a favorable industry for out sourcing countries like Europe, USA and now China (after being expensive). Sialkot Industry would also welcome Joint ventures with Chinese companies for adopting new technologies in the field of Surgical, leather, sports and other prominent sectors of the Industry.

Dr. Humayun Rashid CEO Xavor Said that China and Europe had evolving because of industrial evolution 4.0 and few of the companies could comply with it, being expensive and highly environment friendly only big ventures had adopted it so far. Xavor Corporation had a vast experience in helping out companies to gradually convert their systems into a technology oriented production facilities. He added that Sialkot Industry would have to understand the dimensions of the Joint Venture. Whereas, Mr. Wagas Akram Awan Senior Vice President: said that Xavor Corporation should visit Sialkot Industry in order to find out the prominent and major issues, after which Team of Xavor would be able to provide the solutions to increase efficiency and productivity of the Industry. Industry visit would help them understand the ground reality of the industry, he added.

DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON SURGICAL/ VETERINARY/PERSONAL CARE INDUSTRY



Meeting of Departmental Committee on Surgical/ Veterinary/Personal Care Industry was held on July 17, 2019; Mr. Ikram-ul-Haq, Chairman Committee welcomed the members and shared the important agenda points. He shared the feedback of a meeting of Sialkot Chamber's Authorities with Chairman FBR regarding the Budget 2019-20; Government's new polices and steps were discussed. He further gave a feedback on committee's working/coordination with Mitsui & Co. Japanese Company) in regard to establish a

Commercial Warehouse of Raw-Materials. He discussed all the perspectives/aspects of that project with the Committee e.g. types & kinds of materials required by the industry, proposed sources of materials, pricing, market trends, comparative analysis of quality & prices of materials, standardization, malpractices of local material supplier etc. After the detailed discussion, all other members endorsed the points to establish a Company "Commercial Warehouse of Raw-Materials". But on the other hand, they also shared their concerns regarding this step. It was also suggested to work on all aspects before taking this step.

Mr. Ikram-ul-Haq also shared about "Research Report on Sialkot Surgical Industry" shared by PILER-ETI for Trade Body's feedback; Research Team of PILER-ETI was studying on Surgical Manufacturing Sector, Labor laws & conditions, Child Labor, Supply Chain etc. He stressed that response should be collective; SIMAP was the representative body of Surgical Industry so that Industry expected that SIMAP should protect its interests on all levels.

VISIT OF MR. RAJA HASSANIEN JAVED, GENERAL MANAGER (OUTREACH – II) SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (SMEDA)



Mr. Raja Hassanien Javed, General Manager (Outreach–II) Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA) had been visited the SCCI on July 17, 2019. Mr. Khawaja Masud Akhtar, President, welcomed all the guests and drew attention of the house towards a proposal of the Deputy Commissioner Sialkot to allow use of one of the floors of SBCC building free of cost for Sialkot Industrial Heritage Museum. He showed his reservations for use of SBCC building for any purpose other than as defined in PC-1 of

the project. He emphasized to decide operational mechanism of the project as soon as possible, so that SBCC could be effectively run to derive maximum benefit for the export industry of Sialkot.

Mr. Raja Hassanien Javed, GM OR-II, SMEDA, expressed gratitude and agreed with the observations of the President that both SMEDA and SCCI should expedite matters for effective management and control of SBCC operations. He proposed to formulate a management agreement for smooth steering of the project during transitional phase until permanent mode of operations would be decided between the parties. While referring to the proposal initiated by the D.C Sialkot regarding use of one floor of SBCC for Sialkot Industrial Heritage Museum, he informed that the request had been moved to the Secretary, Ministry of Industries and Production. He said that matter could be taken up for use of building for limited period of time say one year and minimum operational cost including utility bills to be paid by the District Government. House discussed the matter critically; whereas, President SCCI assured to take all necessary measures to secure access to SBCC building from the basement as highlighted by the honorable auest.

VISIT OF MR. G.L. GNANATHEVA, CONSUL GENERAL OF SRI LANKA TO PAKISTAN



Mr. G.L. Gnanatheva, Consul General of Sri Lanka to Pakistan visited the Sialkot Chamber on July 17, 2019. Mr. Waqas Akram Awan, Senior Vice President welcomed the honorable guest and discussed the trade potential, free trade agreements, market dynamics & opportunities between both the countries. He told that Sialkot was multi commodity market and engaged in manufacturing and exporting Sports Goods, Surgical Instruments, Leather Products, Gloves of all sorts, Textiles Items, Sports Wear, Martial Arts Uniforms & Accessories,

Musical Instruments, Kitchen Ware, Hollow Ware, Knives, Cutlery items and Military Uniform Badges etc. all over the world. He shared about the dynamics, products portfolio, working with international brands and trade of Sialkot Industry as business community of Sialkot was playing the role of Roaming Ambassadors who visited different Countries to promote products and to build the image of Pakistan. He said that there was a huge scope for establishing joint ventures and business cooperation between the two countries. Moreover, exchange of trade delegations, study tours and most importantly single country trade exhibitions would also help in promoting bilateral trade. In this regard Colombo Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Consulate of Sri Lanka would play role as resource base for exchanging information.

Mr. G.L. Gnanatheva, Consul General of Sri Lanka to Pakistan thanked the Sialkot Chamber and informed that Pakistan and Sri Lanka have robust bilateral political, Defence and historical linkages. Moreover, he shared that the purpose of the visit was to collaborate for improvement of trade and investment. He told that "Free Trade Agreement" had been signed between Sri Lanka and Pakistan to have duty free access to each other's country by way of granting tariff concessions due to this facility Pakistan was exporting Steel, Towels Bed sheets to Europe and Canada via Sri Lanka; whereas, this FTA would be revised to include more potential sectors in Duty free items. People to people contact were encouraged to develop business relations and promote cooperation hence Pakistan businessmen had established factories in Sri Lanka. He shared the trade volume of both the countries and gave his suggestions for trade expansion.

VISIT OF HIS EXCELLENCY H.E. MR. FURQAT SIDIQOV, AMBASSADOR OF THE UZBEK REPUBLIC

Khawaja Masud Akhtar (SI) President welcomed H.E. Mr. Furqat Sidiqov, Ambassador of Uzbekistan to Pakistan, Mr. Zafar Akhmedov DHM, Mr. Jasur Saidahmedov Third secretary and members at SCCI on July 22, 2019. Both

countries should ensure that their specialties were transformed into a strategic partnership covering all areas of bilateral relations. "Dedicated efforts are needed from both sides to further improve two-way trade." he added. While sharing his views on bilateral trade between both countries, the President stressed that immediate steps were needed to be taken in order to improve bilateral trade. Mr. Wagas Akram Awan, Senior Vice President SCCI said that access of Made in Pakistan products to Uzbekistan may be facilitated through warehouses and dedicated marketing companies for the products. He added that the proposed solution of logistics could boost up trade between the two countries. The dedicated marketing companies and warehouses in Uzbekistan could play a huge role in market expansion for Sialkot Industry.



H.E. Mr. Furgat Sidigov, Ambassador of Uzbekistan thanked the President and mentioned that The Uzbek government was taking incremental steps to reform the business sectors, the Uzbek market was open for the investment in the leather sector, surgical sector, martial arts equipment, sports apparel, and all type of boxing and other gloves in Uzbekistan, the main focus was attracting FDI to Uzbekistan. He said that the Uzbek government was also keen to had joint ventures in the said sectors. The central Asian markets were emerging markets, so there was lots of growth potential for the Sialkot Industry in Central Asia & Russia. Uzbek market had opened its border for the joint ventures, investment, and technology transfer. It had a huge attraction for tourism also, as both countries shared the same historical and religious roots. Mr. Zafar Akhmedov also thanked the President SCCI and mentioned that Uzbekistan was the world's fifth-largest cotton exporter and seventh-largest producer. Uzbekistan was offering incentives for investors in Uzbekistan, especially in Special Economic Zones; tax exemption was different for special sectors. More than 97 companies were operating

in Uzbekistan.

AWARENESS SESSION ON CAPITAL MARKET



Awareness session on "Capital Market" was held on July 22, 2019 at Sialkot Chamber. Khawaja Masud Akhtar, President Sialkot Chamber welcomed Mr. Sarmad Hussain, Regional Head, Pakistan Stock Exchange, Mr. Hassan Zaidi, Additional Joint Registrar, Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan, Mr. Naseer Javed, Assistant Manager (Operations), PSX, Mr. Azhar Javed, Assistant Manager (Operations), PSX, distinguished guests and members of Sialkot Chamber. He requested Mr. Sarmad Hussain to proceed with his presentation.

Mr. Sarmad Hussain, Regional Head, Pakistan Stock Exchange thanked the President and gave presentation on the potential of Pakistan's Capital Market. He said that Pakistan existed on one of the World's most important strategic trade routes in the fast growing intra-regional trading segment of the global economy. Pakistan was the 6th largest most populous country with its 204 million people population, wherein, 50% of the population was under 25 years of age. He apprised that other positive indicators of the market included growing middle class and rising consumer spending in the region. While highlighting the importance of SMEs in the Pakistan economy, he stated that SMEs had the potential to stimulate growth, provided they were delivered with an enabling environment to flourish. He highlighted the facts about SMEs in Pakistan, shared recent history of the Pakistan Stock Exchange and elaborated the pattern of shareholding in PSX and explained the whole eco-system of the capital market. He encouraged the members to enlist on SME Board and explained the mandatory requirements for listing on the Board. He also elaborated the benefits of savings and investment to beat the inflation and meet financial goals. In the end, he defined the procedure to invest rightly in the Stock Exchange. Whereas, Mr. Hassan Zaidi, Additional Joint Registrar, Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan, then delivered a comprehensive presentation on Investors Protection Initiatives of SECP. He explained the major reforms introduced by SECP including Framework for Centralized Customer Compensation Fund, Direct Settlement Services and National Custodial Services, Standardization of broker software, E-Access services including IVR, SMS, email and online alerts, Implementation of e-IPO, e-Voting etc. In the end, Mr. Khawaja Masud Akhtar thanked the honorable guest speakers from PSX and SECP for conducting an informative session for the benefit of members.

AWARENESS SESSION ON "ISLAMIC BANKING" BY BANK ISLAMI PAKISTAN PVT LTD



Khawaja Masud Akhtar (SI) welcomed the team of Bank islami Pakistan for conducting awareness seminar on July 24, 2019 with the purpose to create awareness on the fundamental principles, operations, available investment and financing tools by Islamic Banking. The seminar was conducted by Mufti Muhammad Javaid, a senior member of the Shariah board of the Bankislami Pakistan. He discussed the use of finances by commercial & Islamic banks, comparative analysis on risk sharing ratio, types of Partnership (mudarabah, Musharakah, Diminishing Musharakah, Ijara, Profit & loss sharing, takaful etc.) and source of capital etc. of commercial as well as the Islamic banks.



He also elaborated all the types of Islamic products/ concepts in detail. Although Islamic Banks were currently operating in accordance to the Kibor (The Karachi Interbank Offered Rate), it was not the interest rate, it was the market rate determined by the supply and demand mechanism by banking operations. Islamic Banking was introduced in Pakistan in 1977, but it did not get much popularity among the masses, so it was reintroduced in 2001 again through the SBP, and currently, leading banks were operating under the Shairah Compliance. Currently, Islamic Banks were holding 15% of the market share while 85% share was held by conventional banks, so in order to influence the market, the Islamic banks needed more market share. Discussion and Q/A sessions were also held after completion the presentation to satisfy the audience.

VISIT OF 39TH SPECIALIZED DIPLOMATIC COURSE FROM FOREIGN SERVICE ACADEMY



Khawaja Masud Akhtar, President SCCI welcomed the 39th specialized diplomatic course delegation from Foreign Service academy and members of Sialkot Chamber on July 26, 2019 and appreciated the role of Foreign Services academy for the capacity building and training of the Officers. He expressed hope that all officers would strive hard to project a positive image of Pakistan on all diplomatic avenues. He told about the Sialkot as an export industrial city of Pakistan. He further elaborated about the Sialkot Chamber as a mother body of Sialkot Industry and its remarkable role for the growth & development of Sialkot Business Community. He briefed about the active role of Sialkot Chamber in completing various development projects on self-help basis and also introduced new project of AIRSIAL to provide quality air travel services to the people. He stressed that the diplomats of Pakistan should cooperate with business community of their homeland to establish marketing companies and warehouses on pattern of UAE.

Head of Delegation thanked the President for warm welcome on behalf of Foreign Service Academy and said that purpose of the visit was to acquire knowledge about the industry of Sialkot so that after appointment as foreign diplomats, the officers would not only address the issues but also contribute to promote the export of Pakistan. He appreciated the detailed documentary of Sialkot Chamber and efforts relating to socio-economic development of the City which was possible due to vibrant people of Sialkot. He added that 2.5 (M) US\$ foreign exchange of Sialkot could surge 20 (B) US\$ with the efforts of Businessmen of Sialkot. Chinese model of warehouse establishment could be replicated in this connection Officers would extend support to promote the export of Pakistan. President open the house for "Question and Answer Session" to further discuss the concerns in detail.

DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS



Meeting of Departmental Committee on Women Entrepreneur was held on July 27, 2019. Dr. Mariam Nouman, Chairperson Committee chaired the meeting welcomed and introduced Mr. Ahtesham Gillani, Chairman SCCI's Departmental Committee on Environment Protection. Mr. Ahtesham Gillani appreciated the practice of Departmental Committee on Women Entrepreneurs to invite any one of the chairmen of SCCI's Committees in committee meetings. He shared about the Government's supervision & role by Environment Protection Department; he briefed about the rules, duties and authorities of the said Department. He also explained about the objectives and working of his Committee. He also told about "Sialkot Tannery Zone (STZ)" – a project which had been initiated by the Sialkot Chamber under the departmental committee on environment protection. He shared the background, Government's contribution/cooperation and current status of STZ Project. He also presented the map of STZ and shared its future prospects and significance. He announced the "Plantation Week" would be celebrated by SCCI in coming week; also shared the details of plants & seeds (of fruit & vegetables) which would be available at SCCI on reasonable prices. He encouraged and invited the WEC members to join with SCCI in said regard, in order to promote Plantation on all levels as it was important to protect the environment.

Dr. Mariam Nouman shared about the training workshop which would be held at SCCI with the mutual efforts of both the committees. Ms. Syeda Seema Khuled hired as professional trainer for the said session; her major expertise in growing fruits, trees and kitchen gardening. She encouraged all the members to join the training session and to create awareness about gardening among others too. Furthermore, she told that an invitation was also extended to Ms. Khawar Mumtaz, President National Commission on the Status of Women (Government of Punjab) to visit SCCI by the Women Entrepreneurs Committee; so that the issues/concerns of female entrepreneurs of Sialkot could be addressed. She explained the objective and working of this government Department for the protection of females' legal rights. Further, elaborated the legal services of this Department provided to the women at the time of need. She also shared the feedback and progress of rural women entrepreneurs after "10-Day Training Session on Online Business & Social Media Marketing" had held at SCCI with the collaboration of Baidarie, Sialkot.

TRAINING PROGRAM ON NTN & STRN REGISTRATION & E-FILLING OF RETURNS

The Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry in collaboration with Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA) organized One-Day training program on "NTN & STRN Registration &E-filling of Returns" on July 30, 2019. The purpose of the program was to train the attendees regarding Eregistration and E-filing of income tax return, NTN, IRIS, Legal requirements related to the tax filing and how to handle the FBR notice(s) regarding income tax return/wealth statement. The training was provided by Mr. Muhammad Ijaz, Income Tax Practitioner (ITP), he had more than 15 years of experience in the field. Mr. Muhammad Ijaz, Income Tax Practitioner (ITP), thanked SCCI and SMEDA for organizing this important session for the business community of Sialkot. He explained the concepts and methodologies of E-Filling, Electronic Filling, and FBR E-File in detail. AOP (Association of Persons), Company and Individual could avail e-filing service (provided that it fulfills the requirements of FBR); as it would be very convenient, secured, accurate method with all the proof of filing. Furthermore, he shared the

details of documents required for NTN Registration and informed that requirements had a little alteration for the salaried person and Partnership Firms, SCEP Company registration, Income tax return, sales tax registration accordingly. He said that same documents were required for the manual filing of the tax return. He also shared with the house the Refund application process.

JOINT MEETING OF DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEES ON BANKING & FINANCE AND SURGICAL INDUSTRY/VETERINARY/PERSONAL CARE INDUSTRY WITH TEAM OF STATE BANK-SIALKOT OFFICE



Joint Meeting of Departmental Committees on Banking & Finance and Surgical Industry/Veterinary/Personal Care Industry with Team of State Bank-Sialkot Office was held on August 02, 2019 in order to discuss the agenda "One of the strategic goals under SBP Vision 2020 is to increase financial inclusion for which SBP is focusing on promoting development finance sectors through various initiatives. In line with the strategic direction of SBP, provision of financing to SMEs is also one of the priority areas; therefore, SBP has launched a sector specific approach for development of various SME sectors. "SURGICAL SECTOR" has been chosen for the 1st year to be given special focus during the year of FY19-20 for promotion and development of this sector. Aim of this initiative is to identify issues faced by Surgical Industry, their solution/suggestions which may be taken up at appropriate forums. Therefore, a meeting is arranged at SCCI to discuss the said initiative and concerns of Surgical Industry of Sialkot."

Mr. Waqas Akram Awan (Senior Vice President), Mr. Ikram-ul-Haq, Mr. Shafiqur Rehman and other members briefed the significance & role of financial institutions for an economy and said that the mutual working of Government as a facilitator and financial institutions were the key to economic empowerment of a country. He discussed the impediments/hurdles in the way of economic prosperity of Pakistan and shared some of the factors e.g. problems in access to finance, lack of short-

term & long-term economic policies, issues in implementation of business friendly policies for SMEs, weak linkages between different departments etc. It was recommended that R&D fund should be designed by SBP; he suggested that almost 5% of the turnover of any export company, R&D fund should be facilitated by the bank on No-Interest basis. This fund could be used in following three dimensions; MDR Certification, Technology Adaptation and Diversification in Product Line. Detailed suggestions were shared by the chairmen committees and members and stressed that Ms. Kashifa Nosheen (SBP-Sialkot Office) said that SBP Team had to visit different departments, institutions, trade bodies and industrial units to get the information/idea of Sialkot Surgical Industry. She assured that a fruitful & focused result would be produced so that this project would ultimately beneficial for the Industry.

Allied Bank of Pakistan conducted an awareness seminar

Mr. Shahid Amir, Chief Commercial Regional Banking Group shared with the house that the products and policies offered by the Allied Bank. He further mentioned that clean lending was available for the SMEs but because of weak financial statements, it was not possible for the banks to cater them all. He mentioned that Allied Bank started in 1942 and currently it has 1341 branches and more than 1400 ATMs. He also said that for financing facility women entrepreneurs at a minimum interest rate of 6%. He said that financing facility was also available to small traders and manufacturers also. Mr. Naseer Ahmed Malik, former Vice President SCCI mentioned that about 99% products manufactured in Sialkot Industry was exported, so the share of the city in the national export was up to 14% to total economy. He also appreciated the remarkable role played by the Allied Bank for the trade facilitation extended to Sialkot. He mentioned that strong services provided by the institutions always played an important role to earn a good repute to the institute. He thanked Allied Bank of Pakistan for conducting such an informative session and also thanked the participants for their presence. He wished that the meeting would help to bridge the gap between the customers and the banking services.

MEETING OF DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON BADGES INDUSTRY

He informed the house that, while having a conversation with the officials of Defense Export Promotion Organization (DEPO), he invited the officials of DEPO for a Seminar/ Awareness Session in this Chamber, for the members to know how to participate in the defense exhibitions through DEPO and what sort of facilitation could members get from them. He assured that very soon an Awareness Session by DEPO would be arranged in this Chamber by again making contact with the officials of DEPO and this Committee especially strived hard for the SME's of Sialkot Industry to make it possible for them to visit there and get more business for the homeland.



Furthermore, he informed that hand embroidery Badges was an important portion of Badges Industry, but unfortunately due to lack of proper training and coaching, new workers was not entering into this field. He also said that Ladies workers should be provided proper picker pick and drop service in the Stitching Center. All Committee members endorsed the initiative taken by the Chairman Committee in terms of establishment of Training and Stitching Center at Zaffarwal Road, Sialkot. He also invited the attention towards the recent Government policies, Prices of the Raw-materials and imposition of taxes, he opened the house for discussion that how Badges Industry was affected due to this sudden change in the policies and what steps Industry should be taken in order to overcome the current scenario. Members discussed the concerned matter with their valuable suggestions.

MEETING OF DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE ON MEDIA/ CYBER CRIME

Meeting of Departmental Committee on Media/ Cybercrime was held on August 05, 2019; Mr. Omar Khalid, Chairman Committee welcomed all the

members and briefed the house about the case of M/s. Kissana Leather that letters had been written by this Chamber to respected departments, in Sweden, Hong Kong, and the concerned banks, but the replies were still awaited. A Security Company from Lahore was asked for the Penetration Testing, penetration testing refers to the ethical hacking, in order to have the knowledge of the vulnerability of the cyber security of any business. He discussed that the main sources of the threat were cheaper websites and mentioned that GCWU Sialkot had quite a secure server approved by HEC. GCWU Sialkot was also on board in the said regard, it would be academia and industry collaboration.



Mr. Sohaib (ORIC-GCWU) Sialkot shared the solution provided by the GCWU and mentioned that University was ready to make collaboration in the said regard; this business plan would provide classical security, with the best possible, informed system. Committee members were also discussed the burning issues regarding the agenda point. The routed payments were done by some expert with proper planning; it was difficult to retrieve those payments, so prevention was better than cure. They discussed the carelessness of business community to take preventions to secure their transactions; solutions were also discussed in detail.

VISIT OF MS. ALICE CLARKE FROM BRITISH HIGH COMMISSION TO SIALKOT CHAMBER

Khawaja Masud Akhtar (SI) welcomed Ms. Alice Clarke Senior Trade Policy Advisor British High Commission for visiting Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry on August 08, 2019. The exporters of Sialkot were enjoying the status GSP Plus; many of them had acquired orders from European markets including The United Kingdom under the same status. He further added that withdrawal of which would affect the competitiveness of the exporters, since industry was jolting due to commencement of New Tax regime. He further added that Sialkot Chamber would be looking for Joint Ventures and Transfer of technology for the sectors like Surgical, Leather, Sports Goods and others. He further

added that specifically for the surgical sector, Sialkot Chamber was looking for a joint venture for upgrading furnace.



Ms. Alice Clarke Senior Trade Policy Advisor British High Commission: Thanked President SCCI and said that since The United Kingdom was leaving European Union (Brexit), The Government of The UK would introduce their own scheme which would ensure smooth transition of trade with The UK. She further added that The UK Government had already completed the legislation for the new Scheme (similar to GSP Plus) in case The United Kingdom leaved EU without a deal. She further added that shipments coming under EU would be having relaxation under the status. She further said that The UK Government was providing The UK Export Finance worth 1 to 4 Billion USD for the Joint Ventures. She said that The UK Government would also initiate awareness program for Brexit. Mr. Jason John Mumtaz Trade & Investment Manager British High Commission: Said that his department was working on projects like Joint Ventures and expansion of the industry and could also help in making joint venture with interested parties of The UK.


