

JOINT MEETING OF STATE BANK OF PAKISTAN AND SIALKOT CHAMBER OF COMMERCE



On 27th January, 2021, A joint meeting of State Bank of Pakistan, BSC Sialkot, and Officials of SCCI was held, wherein Mr. Qaiser Iqbal Baryar, President SCCI, appreciated Mr. Ansar Iftikhar Butt, Chief Manager, SBP Sialkot for attending the meeting. He mentioned that on the visit of Governor State Bank of Pakistan, it was decided to hold a joint monthly meeting to review the updates on various initiatives of SBP, and also to address the issues being faced by exporters of Sialkot.

Mr. Baryar said that SBP should work on building the capacity of the Commercial Banks, to ensure compliance of rules/circulars of SBP and also to facilitate the exporters. He also stressed that State Bank of Pakistan should regularize the Commercial Banks in true sense to facilitate the Industry. He further added that due to lack of technical knowledge, a lot of Commercial Banks were refusing to accept the TERF Scheme of SBP, which should be rectified by SBP.



Mr. Shafiq Ur Rehman, Chairman Banking and Finance Committee said that competent staff within Commercial Bank and SBP should be deployed to address the issues related to Foreign Exchange matters. He added that Commercial Bank were working on moto of profitability not on customer care. He further suggested that all the presentations given via zoom should be recorded as a video which could be uploaded on SCCI website for the benefit and awareness of all the members.

Mr. Ansar Iftikhar Butt, Chief Manager, SBP Sialkot, said that SBP was persistently working to resolve the issues of exporters and was also building the capacity of Commercial Banks and SBP's local staff. He further added that the meeting was called on to discuss the TORs of the Committee. He said that SBP was also organizing sessions to make business community aware of the initiatives taken by Central Bank and also added that a session on FX Portal was in the pipeline. Mr. Iftikhar said that SCCI should share the issues of members to BSC Sialkot, so that the same can be taken up with the Commercial Banks. He also mentioned that the refinance schemes were not being availed as much as SBP deemed from the region.

VISIT OF AMBASSADOR OF PAKISTAN TO ARGENTINA



On January 5th, 2021, Ambassador of Pakistan to Argentina visited SCCI, Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President welcomed the Ambassador H.E. Dr. Khalid Ejaz, and also appreciated TDAP for their efforts to promote the exports of Pakistan. H.E. Dr. Khalid Ejaz, Ambassador of Pakistan to Argentina said that he had planned the visit SCCI, to share an insight of the South American markets and potential of "Made in Sialkot" products, there. He

recommended that exporters should consider South American countries, as they had great potential for sports goods and sport wears, due to trend of Football game. He further added to target market of Chile, as the country was considered Free Trade Promoter, and had signed free trade agreement called "Pacific Joint Alliance" with South American countries. He ensured that the Embassy of Pakistan would ensure maximum facilitation to a delegation or an exporter coming for any trade obligation. Mr. Ambassador added that India had maximum trade share of South American Markets, however, Embassy of Pakistan was working to introduce Pakistani products in majority of the markets.



He further added that a few efforts can help Home & Medical Textile penetrate in South American markets. Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President concluded with a notion that Embassy of Pakistan would ensure provision of prospective buyers, list of standards and certifications, Trade Bodies and potential for making Joint Ventures with South American companies, details of marketing companies and assistance in organizing virtual meetings with potential buyers.

TRAINING OF THE LABOR FROM SOUTH PUNJAB

On January 08, 2021 a meeting was held on the training of Labor from South Punjab. Mr. Qaisar Iqbal Baryar, President Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry welcomed all the participants in the meeting. He shared that the Industry of Sialkot is facing acute shortage of skilled workers due to which production process was hampered. He said that the exporters of Sialkot are dedicated and firmly focused to double the export volume as the Industry could foresee strong export orders in the future. He also

said that that Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) were playing a significant role not only in strengthening the national economy but also providing employment to thousands of workers. He emphasized that the Industrial Units related to Textiles and Leather stitching are facing serious shortage of trained and skilled workforce. He also informed that during the recent visit of Chief Minister Punjab, Sardar Usman Buzdar to Sialkot, he discussed the said issue and suggested that if labor from South Punjab could be trained in their particular areas based on the requirements of Export Sector especially Textile, then the shortage of skilled labor could be managed. Moreover, he shared that CM Punjab very kindly agreed to the suggestion and assured that all possible support would be extended for the training of the workforce.



The House unanimously proposed the following:-

- The idea of South Punjab's labor to be trained was appreciated
- Only those skills should be focused which are needed in the Industry of Sialkot.
- The process requirement varies from Industrial Unit to Industrial Unit.
- Training of the labor should be in Sialkot, so that Industrial Units could also get the benefit from them.
- The support would be taken form EDF for the establishment of the Training Institute.
- A Time bound project be established for the purpose. Since this project would be serving as "Integrated Skill Development Hub" and replacing the activities of Public Sector institution of similar nature, this project should be enabled:-

- To assign status of trainees as "Apprentice/ Trainee"
- Provincial Govt. should notify exemption on EOBI/PESSI Payments for these trainees for 3 years.
- Seht Card be issued to these trainees to cover their PESSI/EOBI equivalent benefits
- Stipend to these Trainees be given out od PSDF/similar Public Funded schemes.
- A campus is to be hired for First Batch while a purpose build Campus to be constructed.
- Budget of relevant districts, from where labor would come for training, should be pooled.

VISIT OF MR. HASAN ASAD ALVI, DISTRICT POLICE OFFICER (DPO), SIALKOT



On January 25, 2021 Mr. Asad Hassan Alvi, District Police Officer (DPO), Sialkot visited Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Mr. Qaisar Igbal Baryar, President Sialkot Chamber welcomed Mr. Asad Hassan Alvi and DSPs of all Circles of Sialkot and thanked them for visiting this Chamber. He said that according to the present law-and-order situation, we should support each other for the betterment and prosperity of Sialkot. President SCCI informed that Sialkot Chamber has formed the Departmental Committee on Crime Watch a Traffic Management / Media under the Chairmanship of Mr. Wagas Akram Awan. He also briefed the functioning of the Departmental Committee on Crime Watch and Traffic Management and said that Police Department may send cases / disputes complaints related to business community to Sialkot Chamber for resolution before registering FIR. He shared that Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry has always enjoyed cordial relations with the Police

Department Sialkot. President SCCI assured that business community of Sialkot fully support the Police Department for improvement of law-andorder situation in Sialkot. He emphasized on the need of signing of MOU between this Chamber and Police Department, Sialkot. He appreciated the positive working approach of Mr. Mazhar Fareed, DSP Traffic, Sialkot. He said that both SCCI and District Police Sialkot may take joint initiatives to maintain law & order situation of the city in the best interest of local economy, and may work on creation of effective traffic management strategies. He requested that District Police should inform the Sialkot Chamber before entering into the premises of any member firm for raids purpose.



Mr. Asad Hassan Alvi, DPO Sialkot thanked President SSCI for his warm welcome. He congratulated the Sialkot Chamber on successfully inaugurated the project of AIRSIAIL. He also appreciated the several successful projects of Sialkot Chamber established under self-help basis i-e SIAL, City Package, Sialkot Dryport Trust, Khudkafalat Rozghar Trust, CSDO etc. The DPO wished to improve the system and it is possible only with the help of civil society and this Chamber. He emphasized that civil society should visit the Police Stations with confidence and without hesitation in case of need. He always instructed their SPs, DSPs and SHOs to deal with complete care and politeness with the complainants. He was quite satisfied on whole law-and-order situation of Sialkot. He informed that rate of registering FIRs has been increased than last year. He shared regarding traffic issues and assured that DSP Traffic Mr. Mazhar Fareed would extend every possible assistance and cooperation of the Police to address the Traffic problems in Sialkot. He said that DSP Traffic has

already been working on the project of road engineering, so that Traffic could manage easily. He ensured his availability to hear the valuable suggestions / recommendations from SCCI to improve law and order situation and for strengthen the relations between Sialkot Chamber and Police Department. In the end, Mr. Asad Hassan Alvi, District Police Officer, Sialkot once again thanked the President and the participants of the meeting.

In response to a question, The DPO replied that population of Sialkot is 4.2 Million but having Police Force of only 2500 in Sialkot, on the other hand Police Force in Gujrat comprising 4600 Police despite having lesser population than Sialkot and said that Political leadership of Sialkot has already taken up the issue of low manpower of Police for its enhancement and availability of latest armors so that Police may control the law-and-order situation efficiently. He also announced and instructed to DSP, Traffic, for establishment of Driving License Counter for facilitation of the members in the SCCI premises.

VISIT OF MR. HASHIM RAZA, CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER SMEDA



On February 10, 2021 Mr. Hashim Raza, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Small and Medium Enterprises Development Authority (SMEDA) visited Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Mr. Qaisar Iqbal Baryar, President Sialkot Chamber welcomed Mr. Hashim Raza and other members of this Chamber in the meeting. He appreciated the efforts of SMEDA in improving the efficiency of the exports industry, through dedicated training, works and multiple programs. He also stressed on enhancing the capacity of Commercial Banks, to ensure compliance

with Central Bank rules and regulations. Mr. Baryar added that Commercial Banks should also be given targets of financing for the Industry, with fixed interest and those who did not comply, shall be penalized. He recommended that a catalog of Sports Industry Development Center (SIDC) should be developed for marketing purpose and achievement made from the project, and also requested Mr. Raza to endorse the project of "Modern Dyeing Facility" to be established within Sialkot. He also informed that towards the end of February 2021, Cargo Train from Sialkot to Karachi would be started. He proposed that SMEDA should also pursue the establishment of EXIM Bank and requested Mr. Hashim Raza, CEO SMEDA to hold next meeting on EXIM in SMEDA's Office. He invited the attention of Mr. Hashim Raza CEO SMEDA to expedite the process of transfer Sialkot Business and Commerce Center (SBCC) to SCCI. President SCCI proposed to inaugurate SBCC on Prime Minister of Pakistan visit to Sialkot expected in March 2021. He further recommended that Ministry of Industries and Production should also write to Prime Minister Office, to invite Prime Minister for the inauguration of SBCC and SCCI would endorse his letter. During the meeting it was suggested that Sindh should be included in process of policy reforms.



Mr. Hashim Raza, CEO, SMEDA, thanked President SCCI and shared that a comprehensive policy had been devised by SMEDA for SMEs, which would focus to simplify the intricate processes to provide ease of doing business, to be implement by Board of Investment (BOI). He added that SMEDA had already relaxed tariff of the multiple raw materials to facilitate the SMEs. Mr. Raza ensured President SCCI

to resolve the issue of transfer of SBCC issue once the internal audit objections within SMEDA would be resolved.

VISIT OF MR. NADEEM MALIK, SUPERINTENDENT ENGINEER GEPCO SIALKOT



On January 06, 2021, Mr. Nadeem Malik, Superintendent Engineer GEPCO Sialkot. visited SCCI, Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry warmly welcomed Mr. Nadeem Malik, Superintendent Engineer GEPCO, Sialkot and highlighted the issues and shared recommendations including Two industrial connection should be allowed in one factory premises for Sialkot Industry, new industrial connection should be issued in minimum time period, overbilling issue, Intimation for Power Shut down Schedule on all Industrial Feeders of Sialkot preferably shut down electricity for maintenance on Sunday or other than working hours, List of already Declared Industrial Feeders should be provided, on Recommendation of Sialkot Chamber more Feeders should be included in the list of Industrial Feeders as industries of Sialkot are scattered all around the city, to ensure 8 hours uninterruptable electricity supply on all industrial dominated feeders of Sialkot during working hours as per procedure adopted by previous government and Problems of the members of Sialkot Chamber should be resolved on priority basis.

Mr. Amer Hameed Bhatti also emphasized that GECPO staff should shut down electricity on Sunday for maintenance purposes. He also informed that he taken up the issue of "rules / notification of ban on issuance of two industrial meter in single premise" and "condition of mandatory personal transformer for the area above 1000 square feet" before D.G

Consumers Affairs NEPRA who clearly informed that above said both rules / notifications had been old therefore NEPRA have been lifted / removed the both rules / notifications. He further demanded that GEPCO, Sialkot should get confirmation from NERPA regarding removal of above rules / notification. Mr. Nadeem Malik thanked the Senior Vice President SCCI, for his warm welcome and assured that he will always remain available to hear and redress the issues/complaints of the members of Sialkot Chamber on priority basis.

VISIT OF MAJOR GENERAL (R) RASHAD JAVED, HI (M) AMBASSADOR OF PAKISTAN TO LIBYA

On February 08, 2021 Major General (R) Rashad Javed, HI (M) Ambassador of Pakistan designated to Libya visited Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Mr. Qaisar Iqbal Baryar, President Sialkot Chamber welcomed the Ambassador to Libya.



H. E. Maj. General (R) Rashad Javed HI (M), Ambassador, informed that people were not interested to invest in Libya due to civil war but elections would be held soon and avenues of business were being unlocked. He said that trading was favorable in the current scenario and shared an example that M/s. Millat Tractors Company had been exported Tractors to Libyan counterpart on advance payment. He also shared that he had been visited various Chambers of Pakistan in order to inform them about the export potential of Pakistan made products to Libya because their import ratio was 80 percent and the major sectors of their import were food, textile, home appliances, Sports, medical equipment's and engineering products. Moreover, skilled workforce was also required in Libya.

He said that Banking issue had been resolved due to a branch of Libyan bank in Bahrein through that channel payments could be received without any hassle. He informed that Free Trade Zone had been established in Libya where facilities of income tax exemptions and tax-free holidays were available for investors. Moreover, rules and regulations of investment would be simplified during the passage of time. He also invited businessmen of Sialkot for investment and motivate them for establishment of collective Wearhouse in Libya. He appreciated the welfare projects of Sialkot Chamber.



Major General (R) Sajid Iqbal, Former Ambassador, said that after a long period of internal development and stability, Libya had begun opening its gates for the whole world by initiating a number of business deals with various countries. Shared that projects of foreign investment and tourism infrastructure development were being given national priority by the Libyan government. He shared that they also wished to establish shipment and hoarding company with the collaboration of Pakistan and also interested in transshipment. He informed that Libya was untapped market and had huge scope of bilateral trade in all sectors, low price and quality assurance be necessary for confidence building with buyers of Libya. He said that LC Shipment was also streamlining due to which bilateral relations between Pakistan and Libya could be strengthened. He assured full cooperation of Pakistan Embassy in Libya.

While highlighting the background of e-payments in Custom he informed that The World Customs Organization (WCO)'s Revised Kyoto Convention Standard 4.6 strongly encouraged the use of electronic funds transfer as an important method for quick and efficient payment. He further informed that the WCO Revised Arusha Declaration also recommended that automated systems should be configured in a way as to minimize opportunities for the inappropriate exercise of official discretion, face-to-face contact between Customs personnel and clients, and the physical handling and transfer of funds. He elaborated that "Online Banking" means round-theclock facility provided to a taxpayer to pay customs duties, taxes and other dues electronically from his bank account through internet banking, automated teller machines (ATM), bank's mobile applications or any other method of E-Payment prescribed by the State bank of Pakistan. Mr. Khuram Aslam thanked Mr. Inam ul Wahid, guests and participants of the seminar and hoped that the seminar would help in better understanding of Government's System for

Online Collection of Taxes through Alternate Delivery Channels.

Industry along with his team for an awareness Session for the members of this Chamber. Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry welcomed Mr. Muhammad Waqas Saeed. He mentioned that internet has become the integral part of today's generation of people; from communicating through instant messages and emails to banking, travelling, studying and shopping, internet has touched every aspect of life. He said that with the growing use of the internet by people, protecting important information has become a necessity.



He said that a computer that is not having appropriate security controls can be infected with malicious logic and thus any type of information can be accessed in moments. He said that number of infected Web Pages and malicious websites could be seen every day infecting the computers and allowing hackers to gain illegal access to other computer systems.



He added that better awareness towards cyber security and proper planning could prove to be very beneficial for business organizations in protecting

Their information and trade secrets from being disclosed. He added that many small business organizations were taking initiatives to protect their information from being accessed illegally. He informed that Sialkot Chamber had a Departmental Committee on Information Technology/ Cyber Crime under the Chairmanship of Mr. Muhammad Kashif Almas, who played his part in order to aware the members for Cyber-attacks. He invited Mr. Muhammad Waqas Saeed to share his views on Cyber Security Issues and its Impacts.

Mr. Muhammad Waqas Saeed, thanked Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President and other participants of the meeting for their warm welcome and hospitality. The following points were extracted from his presentation:

VISIT OF OFFICIALS OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES TAXILA,



On January 18th, 2021, Officials of Heavy Industries Taxila visited SCCI, Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President welcomed the Delegation of HIT, and appreciated Chairman Heavy Industries Taxila for hosting the delegation of Sialkot Chamber of Commerce and Industry, on December 17th, 2020. He added that both of organization can work in collaboration to support and substitute the materials and product being imported. He gave an example of establishing bicycle bottle that can be manufactured in indigenous industries. Mr. Aslam requested the Chairman Departmental Committee on Engineering to formulate a delegation for organize a study tour to Heavy Industries Taxila, in coming future. Brig. Nauman Anwar, Director Commercial/ Member HIT Board said that he had visited SCCI on direction of Chairman to explore the opportunities of

collaboration and working together to reduce import list of Pakistan. He mentioned that a private venture of HIT, M/s. Margilla Hill Pvt Ltd was in the process of registration within SECP and after the top management was hired, they would visit SCCI to explore possibilities to collaborate and work together. Brig. Anwar, said that HIT had been manufacturing Cutting Tools of all sort and manufacturing Dies for multiple industries. He also added that a Special Economic Zone was in plan under CPEC within Taxila region, and a private venture can be established for indigenous requirement, with collaboration.



Mr. Ansar Aziz Puri, Vice President, inquired that whether HIT was providing tools to automobile industry and requested to have samples of products being manufactured in HIT in their liaison office. Brig. Nauman Anwar, responded that HIT had the capacity of meet the local requirement of the industry and would also consider opening of liaison office in Sialkot, and also appreciated the proposal of cricket match in Taxila. The Meeting was concluded with a notion to formulate a delegation of SCCI to visit HIT for 2 days in coming future and afterwards HIT delegation would visit, to understand the dynamics of Industry of Sialkot and collaborate to reduce import list of Pakistan.

TAX AWARENESS SESSION REGARDING TAXPAYERS' ISSUES

On January 18, 2021 Mr. Sarfraz Ahmed Warraich, Advisor Incharge, Federal Tax Ombudsman, Regional Office Gujranwala, visited Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President, Sialkot Chamber welcomed Mr. Sarfraz Ahmed Warraich distinguished guests and members of Sialkot Chamber. He said that Sialkot was the hub of export-oriented industry and business people of Sialkot had always been vigilant in fulfilling their genuine tax liability. He briefed the guests about industrial set up and various products being produced in Sialkot. He mentioned various achievements of the business community in terms of compliance to corporate social responsibility.



Mr. Sarfraz Ahmed Warraich, Advisor Incharge, Federal Tax Ombudsman, Regional Office Gujranwala, expressed gratitude for a warm welcome and referred to his long association with the region of Sialkot during his professional career and even after retirement. He informed that he had been deputed to the FTO Regional Office Gujranwala as Advisor to FTO two weeks ago. He elaborated the process and procedure for filing of complaint with FTO and encouraged the members to avail the system to address issues of maladministration by Tax Authorities.

He informed that Government of Pakistan, established the Federal Ombudsman in 1983 in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution. The Provinces followed suit and established Provincial Ombudsmen. Thus, Pakistan joined the international club of countries having the office of Ombudsman as a critical component of welfare states with adequate focus on service delivery at national and sub-national levels. He said that sectoral needs led the government to establish the office of specialized Ombudsmen for Tax administration, Insurance and Banking sectors. He further informed that Office of the Federal Tax Ombudsman was established in the year 2000

He informed that following legislations controlled

the working of the office of Federal Tax Ombudsman;

- The Establishment of the Office of: Federal Tax Ombudsman Ordinance, 2000
- Investigation and Disposal of Complaints Regulations, 2001

He informed that The core function of Federal Tax Ombudsman revolved around "Disposal of complaints of Tax Maladministration promptly, justly, fairly, independently investigated, and to rectify any injustice done to a taxpayer by actions of the tax employees of Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) / Revenue Division, Government of Pakistan." He said that the Ombudsman's institution in Pakistan did not compete with the courts, or act as a further body to which those unsuccessful in the courts can appeal.



He informed that FTO resolved complaints of the existing and prospective taxpayers and provided relief to the public by carrying out independent investigations about maladministration by functionaries administering the federal taxes. He said that FTO strived to put things right, share lessons learnt and help improve public services and systems. He said that FTO's independent complaints handling service had been free and open to everyone.

He said that FTO aimed to redress taxpayers' grievances as fairly and as quickly as possible after examining all the material facts. He said that if it comes to the knowledge of FTO that the Revenue Division had acted wrongly, the office of FTO would recommend them to put things right for the taxpayers. He said that corrective measures might include recommending the agency to provide relief sought, provide access to information and to treat

taxpayers fairly and in accordance with the law. He said that following issues were beyond the authority of the Federal Tax Ombudsman;

- ✤ Matters that are sub-judice
- 🗞 External and defence Affairs
- Service matters

He said that FTO would look into all the instances of ill-motive, delaying tactics, misinterpretation, omission / commission, negligence, arbitrariness and recklessness at the end of Tax Authorities.

Mr. Khuram Aslam thanked Mr. Sarfraz Ahmed Warraich for visiting Sialkot Chamber and sharing his thoughts with the members. He expressed hope that the awareness session would have helped in better understanding of the members.

VISIT OF MR. RIZWAN MUSHTAQ, GENERAL MANAGER SNGPL, SIALKOT



On January 19, 2021 Mr. Rizwan Mushtaq, General Manager SNGPL, Sialkot visited Sialkot Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President, Sialkot Chamber warmly welcomed the Honorable and thanked him for visiting this Chamber. The Senior Vice President, SCCI, highlighted the following issues.

Chairman handed over the file of pending issues of the members of Sialkot Chamber related to SNGPL, Sialkot.

Mr. Rizwan Mushtaq, General Manager SNGPL, Sialkot, thanked the Senior Vice President for his warm welcome and hospitality extended to him. He appreciated the functioning, working approach and liaising of Sialkot Chamber with all Government Department for resolution of the issues of its members. He also appreciated several successfully established projects of the Sialkot Chamber i-e SIAL, AIRSIAL, SDPT and Sialkot Tannery Zone Ltd.

Mr. Haris, Senior Officer, SNGPL, Sialkot nominated focal person for resolution of the issues of the members of this Chamber. He informed that there was zero load shedding of gas in Sialkot and SNGPL Sialkot was only managing load of gas for distribution of gas to domestic consumers of Sialkot. He shared that SNGPL has 314000 domestic consumers, 51 Industrial and 350 commercial consumers in Sialkot. He informed that SNGPL has been fulfilling domestic consumers need by suppling 50% gas through LNG. He said that, the reason of low pressure of gas was due to increase of demand of gas. Regarding pending connections, he said that connections would be issued on priority. He also informed that LNG based connections are being issued of housing societies as per policy of SNGPL. Moreover, he informed that urgent connections scheme has been suspended temporarily. Furthermore, SNGPL changed the old pipelines on yearly basis in order to avoid leakage issues.

In response to a question, he explained that SNGPL have already been clarified the Army officials through written letter that SNGPL was installed 10" separate lines from Urra Chowk through which connections would be given to villages and consumers of Sialkot-Cantt and assured that due to above gas pressure of Sialkot – Cantt would not be reduced.

VISIT OF MR. MUHAMMAD NADEEM, REGIONAL HEAD EMPLOYEES OLD AGE BENEFITS INSTITUTION (EOBI), SIALKOT

Mr. Muhammad Nadeem, Regional Head, Employees Old Age Benefits Institution (EOBI), gave an insight of working of EOBI including Operational Structure of EOBI, Core Functions of EOBI, EOBI Benefits and Salient Features of EOBI Sialkot Region July-2020 to December-2020. Mr. Khuram Aslam, Senior Vice President thanked Regional Head, EOBI, Sialkot for visiting this and requested that Seminars on imperative issues including Rules & Regulations of EOBI and process of registration, should be organized in future for members awareness.

ONLINE AWARENESS SESSION ON STATE BANK OF PAKISTAN'S (SBP) SHARIAH COMPLIANT RE-FINANCE SCHEMES



On January 21st, 2021, a webinar was arranged on the Shariah Compliant Re-finance Schemes of State Bank of Pakistan, wherein Mr. Ghulam Muhammad Abbasi, Director IBD, SBP, said that the webinar was coordinated upon special request of Mr. Qaiser Iqbal Baryar, President SCCI, and the scope of the discussion was to make exporters of Sialkot, aware of the Re-finance Schemes of SBP available in Islamic version. He added that it was observed that being export capital of Pakistan, a few had availed the Refinance schemes, especially those introduced after COVID-19.

Mr. Shafiq Ur Rehman Chairman, Departmental Committee on Banking and Finance, expressed that efforts to endorse Islamic Banking have to be made on both sides, with a proper awareness compagin. He also added that State Bank of Pakistan should form a Committee for deliberation of Shariah laws into banking practices and he would extend his maximum support to serve the cause. He further added that he would propose a way forward to enhance the aware of Shariah Compliant options with collaboration of SBP and Meezan Bank Ltd.

Mufti Irshad Ahmed Aijaz, Chairman, Shariah Advisory Committee, SBP, highlighted the importance of Shariah laws for Banking and also gave a brief of how advisory board was working to formulate products for individuals and companies who were not willing to utilities conventional banking products. He also endorse the recommendations and proposals of Mr. Shafiq Ur Rehman, Chairman, Banking and Finance Committee, and ensure to co-operate with SCCI for future endeavors.

Mr. Ahmed Ali Siddiqui, Group Head Shariah Compliance, Meezan Bank Limited, gave an insight of products based on Shariah laws and also briefed the participants on Refinance Schemes available on easy terms to propective clients. While speaking to the participants he acknowledged SCCI and SBP for arranging the Webinar and especially Mr. Shafiq Ur Rehman for his recommendations on Islamic Banking reforms.

AWARENESS SESSION ON STATE BANK OF PAKISTAN'S (SBP) FX PORTAL



On January 28st, 2021, a webinar was arranged on the FX Portal launched by SBP, wherein Mr. Shaukat Zaman, Group Head, SBP, said that the a webinar was organized to brief the exporters about the newly launched online portal for FX-related cases, The system, is an online platform, End-To-End Digitalization of FX Cases, for Commercial banks to interact with the SBP, or the SBP Banking Services

Corporation (SBP-BSC), for submission of cases and to receive regulatory decisions, accordingly. These cases are handled by SBP's Exchange Policy Department (EPD), Foreign Exchange Operations Department (FEOD) and BSC. Using SBP's RAS, banks will electronically submit FX operations-related cases to the Foreign Exchange Operations Department (FEOD), with paper-based submission having been abolished. Similarly, the main idea behind this system is to keep business customers updated about the status of their requests routed through banks, from the day it is received at the SBP. Customers will receive system generated update status reports at their email address provided by the bank, from the time of case submission till completion.

Mr. Shafiq Ur Rehman Chairman, Departmental Committee on Banking and Finance, endorsed the efforts of SBP and appreciated adaptation of paperless environment being opted by the Central Bank. He further requested that SBP should ensure its complete utilization in Commercial banks and should expedite quires of clients, if any.

Mr. Fahad Masood, USB representative, gave an insight of how FX portal of UBL would be work and the client would be facilitated through utilization of the portal. He thanked the concerned within State Bank of Pakistan for arranging the webinar and taking Commercial Bank on board.

VISIT OF 50th PN STAFF COURSE OF PAKISTAN NAVY WAR COLLEGE LAHORE

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Human Rights: "Lebensraum of Cashmere"

On another occasion in (Tyrol) Austria, I was sitting in the lawns of the hotel where I was staying; a bearded man approached me and he started to convince me to become a Christian. I was dumb-founded at his attempt. It was unbecoming of the hotel management to have allowed nobody ever dares or likes to insult any holy books like Bible, Torah, Gita or The Vedas etc. To do so, is punishable under law. In my country the Christians and other religionist live together and enjoy complete freedom and harmony. Criticism of other religious faiths is not done by the people by habit and it has also strictly been forbidden in Islam. It is definitely a better and civilized way of life.

I come back to my preceding paragraph. Pakistan which also claims the region (Kashmir) condemned the Indian move as 'illegal'. The "Pakistani Ministry of

A similar attempt was faced by me in my apartment in Gothenburg (Sweden), a couple of years ago, which too was despised by me, despite the fact that I have an open heart. But I believe in firm personal freedom and do not like to be disturbed by others especially when they are un-invited, unexpected and naturally not welcome. I wonder how such people are let loose. I feel happy that in a Muslim society to which I belong to,

Foreign Affairs" warned India of any 'unilateral steps' to change the internationally committed status of Kashmir. "As a party to this conflict, Pakistan will use all possible options o counter these illegal steps", stated the ministry of foreign affairs in Islamabad.
